GENERAL INFORMATION

RULES - This Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the American Horse Shows Association, Rule XVI - Arabian Horse Division. The official Rule Book of the USEF will prevail for this show. This Prize List is based on the Rules of the current Rule Book; any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become part of this Prize List. Each participant in this show is responsible for a knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Questions not covered by USEF Rules shall be decided by the Show Committee and its decision will be final.

REGISTRY REQUIREMENTS - A copy of both sides of the registration papers showing proof of ownership for each horse entered in the show must be submitted with entry form at the time of making entry. In the case of a sale or lease, it is required that a contract of the sale or lease, or statement from the owner be submitted with the copy of the registration papers. Horses entered in AOTR or JOTR classes must be registered in the name of the competitor or member of competitor's family as defined by USEF Art. 132 (or farm solely owned by family). Purchase contracts or bills of sale cannot be accepted.

USEF MEMBERSHIP RULE

USEF EQUESTRIAN Membership Requirement: Effective 12/1/08) LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NONMEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30 NONMEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE: 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (ACADEMY CLASSES ARE CLASSES LIMITED TO HORSES USED REGULARLY IN A LESSON PROGRAM); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PASDE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS. 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES, 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION, 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

USEF Affidavits: Effective December 1, 2008 if members do not have the proper USEF membership documents and the show does not have the ability or opportunity to verify the membership information, the exhibitor will be assessed a \$30 non-refundable non-member fee.

AMATEUR/OWNER TO RIDE CLASSES

An Owner's Class is one in which every contestant is an Amateur and the rider, handler, or driver is the Owner or an Amateur Member of the owner's family (See GR106). Combined ownership is not permitted in Amateur/Owner classes unless all owners are members of the same family. Leased horses are not eligible for amateur owner to ride classes

USEF AMATEUR CERTIFICATION

Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. This certification must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the competition secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such certification provided by the Federation. Forms may be obtained from the Federation. Certification will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur certification.

An amateur continues to be such until he/she has received a change in status from the Federation. Any amateur who wishes to be re-classified on the grounds that he/she has engaged or is planning on engaging in activities which would prevent him/her from continuing to remain an amateur must notify the Federation in writing. COPIES OF AHA & USEF

MEMBERSHIP CARDS - AHA has resolved that owners, trainers, riders/drivers/handlers must provide a photo copy of their current AHA and USEF or CEF membership card with their entry form.

NUMBER OF ENTRIES IN EACH CLASS - Any class with fewer than three (3) entries after Close of Entries may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be combined with another class or cancelled, and the exhibitors in the class(es) will be notified accordingly. Large classes may be divided and conducted as two separate classes with duplicate prizes and awards, except Championship performance classes.

CANCELLATION OR SUBSTITUTION OF ENTRIES - To encourage early entries, the management agrees to cancel and refund all fees on any horse not fit to show provided a vet certificate is given to the Show Secretary on or before the entry closing date. Under no circumstances will any fees be refunded to exhibitors cancelling their entries for any reason after the official closing date. Substitution of horse will be permitted in accordance with USEF Art 1506.

PARKING & TRAILER AREAS - Specific areas have been set aside for parking of horse trailers and vans of exhibitors reserving stalls. Special parking areas will be made available for exhibitors showing from trailers. Fire regulations prohibit parking between or in front of the barns.

STABLING FACILITIES - Box stalls with doors will be available at a fee of \$95.00 each, including one bale of bedding (**for horse stalls only**). NO STRAW MAY BE USED. Grooming and tack rooms are available at a fee of \$95.00 each. Each animal must be assigned a separate stall (except broodmares with suckling foals) unless no stall is requested, in which case a grounds fee will be charged. Stalls will be available after **12 NOON THURSDAY, MAY 26th** and must be vacated immediately after the show, unless you are staying for Region 1. If you are staying for Region 1, you will NOT BE ALLOWED to move to new stalls between shows

CLOSE OF ENTRIES - Entries close May 12, 2011. Post entries will be accepted, up to one session prior to the class. NO POST ENTRIES will be accepted for Dressage classes. *No post entry penalty for the Fun Classes.*

Entries that are submitted, for the first time, after May 12, 2011 will be charged \$50.00 per horse flat post entry fee for the entire show, per horse. Class fees remain the same as published. A United States Postal Service postmark will take precedence over postmarks from private meters, etc. Entries made at the show will be assessed a surcharge.

PADDOCK AREA CONDUCT - There shall be no conduct in the paddock area which disturbs or creates a hazard to horses or handlers. There will be no whips, noise-makers or other equipment, devices, or objects allowed in the paddock area which might disturb or create a hazard to horses or handlers in the area, with the exception of the show whip properly carried by a handler in the paddock area.

LOCATION OF CLASSES - Show management reserves the right to hold classes, or portion of classes on the grounds outside the main ring if it is found necessary to do so or to change and modify the schedule of events as necessary to accommodate the entries received.

AMATEUR CERTIFICATION - Every person who has reached his or her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under USEF rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the USEF. This certification which must be renewed annually, will expire on November 30, and must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the Show Secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such certification. In the event a person holds an unrevoked certification but does not have it in his immediate possession the Show Secretary may accept a signed affidavit to that effect which must be submitted to the USEF.

CLASS CALLS - Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system to carry class calls; however, no protest will be upheld, nor will any class be changed on the basis of PA malfunction alone.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR - Riders in all classes where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the show grounds must wear protective headgear. (Exception: Trail classes). All juniors riding in Hunter, Jumper and Hunterseat Equitation must wear properly fitting certified headgear while riding in the designated schooling and exercise areas, the show ring and while jumping anywhere on the competition grounds. Harnesses must be secured and properly fitted. All riders are strongly encouraged to wear protective headgear passing or surpassing current applicable ASTM standards with harness secured while riding anywhere on the competition grounds. It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition and the USEF, AHA, Show Committee and Licensed Officials are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance.

Effective March 1, 2011, for dressage: Anyone mounted on a horse must wear protective headgear except those riders age 18 and over while on horses that are competing only in FEI levels and tests at the Prix St. Georges level and above (including FEI Young Rider Tests, the USEF Developing Prix St. Georges Test and the USEF Brentina Cup Test).

DRUGS & MEDICATIONS - USEF requires that all exhibitors competing at USEF Recognized Competitions in California must pay a \$20 drug fee (\$7 USEF Drug, \$8 USEF, \$5 CA) per horse entered.

JUDGES - If for any reason a judge fails to attend this show or to perform his/her duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for one who is officially designated in the Prize List. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make any remarks during the show that are considered offensive and/or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging (see USEF Rule VII). No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision, or at any time unless he first obtains permission from the Show Committee or Steward, who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place.

BREEDING/IN-HAND CLASSES

Horses to be shown in-hand at walk & trot. Judges must require handlers to walk all horses quietly on the rail prior to placing the class. Horses must be serviceably sound, i.e., horse must not show evidence of lameness, broken wind or complete loss of sight in either eye (See USEF Art 1204.5). Halter horses are not to be stretched. Transmissible weaknesses shall be considered a serious fault in breeding stock. Colts and stallions two years old and over must have both testicles descended. A suitable headstall equipped with throatlatch is mandatory. Emphasis shall be placed upon type, conformation, substance & quality. The horses must have good manners and a pleasant attitude. One whip or crop per handler allowed, however, whips are not mandatory and handlers are allowed to use items such as grass, hat and/or treats to maintain horse's attention. Whips are to be no longer than 6' including snapper or lash. No appendages of any kind are permitted on the end of the whip. Excessive use of the whip or actions that may disturb other entries shall be severely penalized. Judges must excuse from the ring, any horse shown at halter that possess a whip mark (welt) on any portion of the horse.
